

SUMMER CAMP

FAQ'S

High School:

What is the cost?

Orchard's high school camp will cost \$550 this year. This includes the camp cost, transportation, and all meals while we are gone. Snacks during travel (if wanted) will need to be purchased separately by the student. The initial deposit of \$100 is due with your registration and all final payments are due by May 10.

Where and when is camp?

High school camp, CIY MOVE, is located in Glorieta, New Mexico. Camp will be from June 22 - June 26

What is Move high school camp?

MOVE is a 5-day summer event designed for high school students to know Jesus better, deepen their relationships, and to be sent out to do Kingdom Work

What is your required student-to-leader ratio?

10:1. We believe the 10:1 ratio allows your group to break up into small groups, facilitate the elements and connect with your students on a much deeper level! For Orchard, this team includes our Students staff team and 3-4 volunteers.

Middle School:

What is the cost?

Orchard's middle school camp will cost \$500 this year. This includes the camp cost, transportation, and all meals while we are gone. The initial deposit of \$100 is due with registration and all final payments are due by May 10th.

What is included in the cost?

The cost per person includes meals, lodging, a camp T-shirt, Bible study material, and all Student Life programming. Things like the Student Life Store and snack shops/vending machines (availability varies by campus) are not included.

Where and when is camp?

Middle school camp, Camp Rec, is located in Estes Park, Colorado at YMCA of the Rockies. Camp will be from June 3 - June 7 (times of travel TBD at this time).

What is Camp Rec like?

Camp Rec includes engaging worship from experienced worship leaders, learning through sound biblical teaching and Bible study, community in Life Groups, and fun at recreation!

How will my student get to camp?

Vehicle details are TBD but travel to and from camp is provided by Orchard.Church. All Students will depart from Orchard's Brighton location and will travel as a group to camp.

What can we do to fundraise?

Fundraising opportunities are determined by the student/family. We suggest options such as babysitting, yard clean-up, etc where you can then provide Orchard's payment form and the person could pay directly to the student's camp registration form. Families can also look for donations on their own and have these made directly through the form. If you have any questions, we are happy to answer individual questions to support your student's fundraising efforts.

What should my student pack?

- Bible
- Notebook and pen/pencil
- Clothing for five days, including travel time
- Personal toiletry items, including prescription medication
- Towel
- Bedding/sleeping bag to fit a twin bed
- Money for travel (2 meals, snacks if wanted), the MOVE Store, offering, etc
- (optional) Athletic attire for recreation time; great walking/hiking shoes are strongly recommended
- Additional items may be added as we are closer to camp dates

How will my student get there?

Who attends with them?

Vehicle details are TBD but travel to and from camp is provided by Orchard.Church. All Students will depart from Orchard's Brighton location and will travel as a group to Estes Park. Our Students staff team and 3-4 volunteers attend with students each year.

What are the sleeping arrangements?

Eastside Lodges at YMCA of the Rockies offer close walking distance to the Worship Center and recreation fields. Most rooms include 2 sets of bunk beds and 1 queen-size bed. Bed linens will be provided but you'll need to bring your own towels!

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What should my student pack?

- Bible
- Notebook and pen/pencil
- Clothing for five days, including travel time
- Personal toiletry items, including prescription medication
- Towel
- Bedding is provided for you, but you can opt to bring an additional blanket if needed
- (optional) Athletic attire for recreation time; great walking/hiking shoes are strongly recommended
